## **PAX** Community

Minutes for General Membership Meeting January 29, 2017

The meeting was opened with a prayer at 11:00 at the meeting room of the Blueberry Hill community following the mass.

## New Bishop

The first item for discussion was the question of PAX's response to the installation of a new bishop. Doug Spaulding reviewed the process undertaken by the Community to gather views about how PAX should proceed. He summarized the responses from several PAX celebrants, members of our community and others who uniformly recommended that PAX not take steps to reach out to the new bishop at this time, but rather to take a "wait and see" approach. After some further discussion, the clear consensus of the meeting was to follow that advice. The steering committee committed to returning to the full community before taking any steps that would bring PAX to the attention of the new bishop.

#### **New Website**

Doug provided background on problems with the PAX website and the desire over many years to upgrade the site. He reported that the Steering Committee had authorized the expenditure of \$800 for the

services of a web designer to help create a new website for PAX. The new site is currently being tested and improved by a committee of PAX members including: Doug, Paula, Ron, Charlie, Megan, June, Tao, Nellie and Rhonda. Doug provided a demonstration of the new site to the members who indicated that they were pleased with the direction of the website improvements. Further work needs to be done, but the new site is expected to be ready soon. Further information on the new website will be disseminated on our listsery.

#### **PAX Education Committee**

Sylvia gave a report on the PAX Education Committee. A copy of the Committee's report is attached. She also asked for volunteers to assist in planning a PAX retreat for later this year.

## **PIN Cushion Report**

Marian gave a report on the PIN Cushion Committee. A copy of the summary of PIN Cushion donations is attached. Maria Teresa reported on the impact these donation have for some of the people we have helped, and she shared their expressions of gratitude to the PAX Community.

## **Treasurer's Report**

Judy gave the treasurer's report. Copies of the Fourth Quarter and Annual Reports for 2016 are attached. The Community authorized the Treasurer to obtain a credit card for PAX expenditures.

### Miscellaneous

The Community was not in favor of an expenditure of funds for new pewter cups. The Community approved the request to offer Fr. Vince Cushing the \$169 registration fee for a conference in April that he expressed interest in attending.

The meeting concluded at 12:40.

The PAX Education Committee has presented a number of programs in 2016, with a goal of one gathering a month.

Early in the year, participating in an IEC meeting enabled us to learn about IECs in the Metro area. Using PAX-L, we continue to inform PAX members of events offered by NOVA, in particular, which is especially active in the areas of peace and social justice. It has been proposed that the IEC's meet again this year, in February, with a theme of social/environmental justice, It was noted that NOVA holds an annual retreat, to better educate and learn from each other, and to build their sense of community. The Listserv is also used to communicate information on valuable programs close by, e.g. Georgetown and Catholic University, and for sharing of articles of interest.

Our brunch programs at Pulcinella's Restaurant have been popular, drawing 25 or 30 each time. Speakers included:

Sarah Spengeman from NETWORK, on the activities of the Nuns on the Bus; a documentary on the lives of immigrants from Central America and Mexico; a speaker on immigration and Syrian Refugee Projects in Syria and surrounding countries; a film, The Incredible Journey of the Butterflies, tracing their journey and disappearance; a film documentary, Unacceptable Levels, showing how toxic chemicals have become a part of our lives; our annual OXFAM fast, focusing on world hunger; the Secretary General and Marie Dennis, Co-President of PAX Christi International speaking on their programs for peace and reconciliation. After each program, participants were given information for follow-up on what was presented.

Advent continued our focus on issues of Immigration and the refugee crisis, hosted by the Syrian Refugee Committee.

In the coming months, there will be a series of meetings at Pulcinellas: February – Film, <u>Before the Deluge</u> by Leonardo di Caprio March - SALT, John Horesji will speak on legislative issues Lenten Series - Fr. Ted Keating will present a series on <u>Nonviolent Resistance</u> April - A speaker and/or event honoring the Earth

We plan to visit the retreat center at Holy Cross Abbey, in Berryville, and will view the film <u>Saving Place</u>, Saving Grace, by Deidra D. Dain (<u>Deidra@picturefarmerfilms.com</u>). Deidra may speak later in the year.

Other areas of interest include: the teachings and philosophy of Teilhard de Chardin; a presentation by Les Myers on the economy, and the work of the Center of Concern; the possibility of a book club; exploration of Right to Life in all its forms, including the life of the planet; prison reform; end of life issues, and socially responsible investing.
